
36 national commitments to date

## Benchlearning and monitoring of the implementation of the Council Recommendation

**Benchlearning** is a targeted support to Member States that combines benchmarking and mutual learning to improve apprenticeship systems/schemes.

We work together with Member States to improve apprenticeship systems in Europe and create more opportunities for learners of all ages.

The **monitoring exercise** is important, as it allows Member States and the European Commission to identify what areas covered by the Council Recommendation still need to be addressed.




